BE WHAT THE WORLD NEEDS CAMPAIGN OVERVIEW



The **Be What the World Needs** campaign is the largest and most ambitious fundraising initiative in the history of both the University of Saskatchewan and the province. Launched with a bold goal of **\$500 million**, the campaign exceeded expectations—raising **\$570,739,155** and marking a historic milestone for the university's future.

CAMPAIGN HIGHLIGHTS

- **Purpose:** Advance the University Plan *The University the World Needs* through a decade long comprehensive fundraising effort.
- **Duration:** 2015–2025
- **Goal:** \$500M
- **Final Achievement:** \$572.1M (114% of goal)
- **Scope:** More than **2,600 initiatives** funded across research, student success, Indigenous achievement, and capital projects.

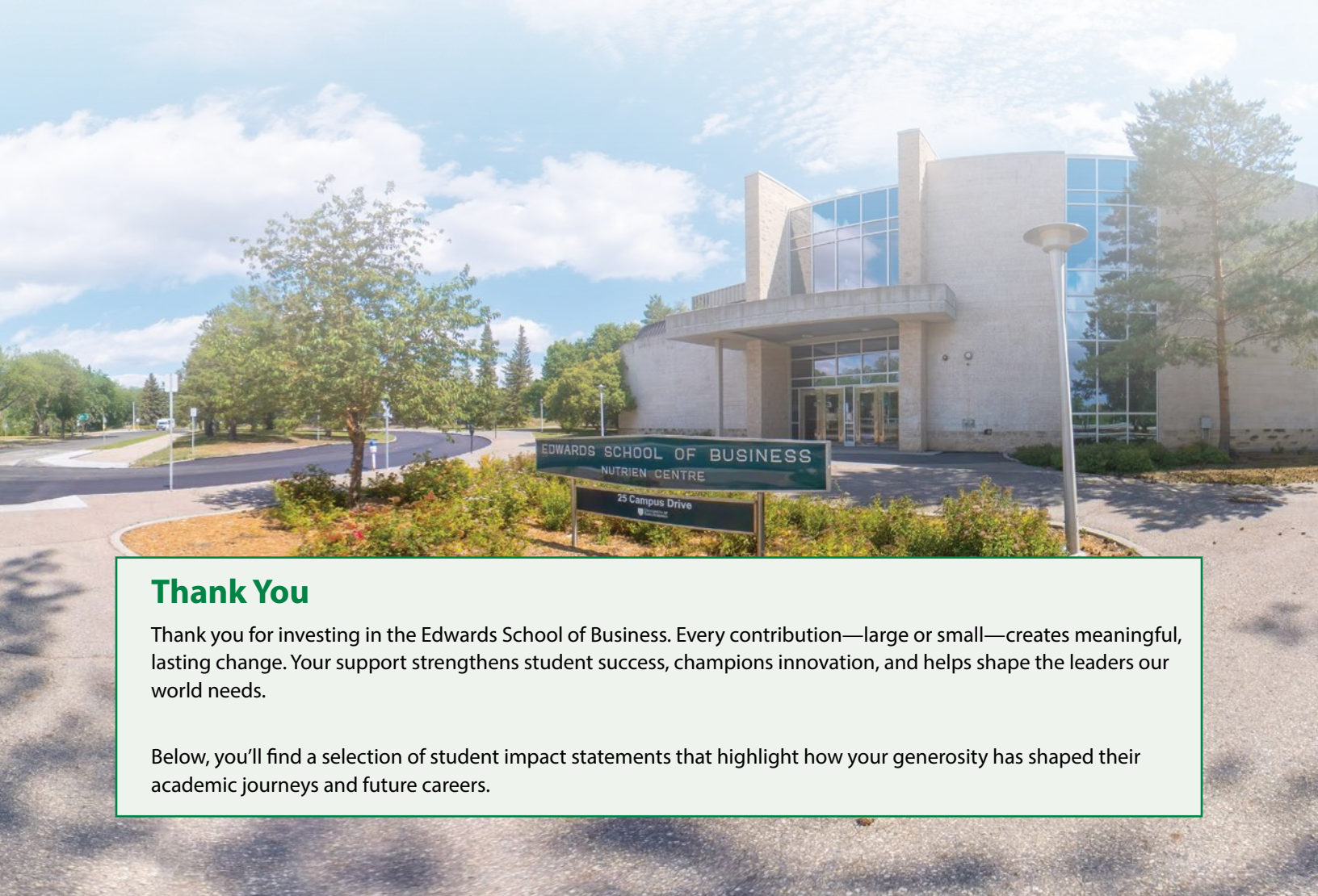
2025 EDWARDS FUNDING HIGHLIGHTS

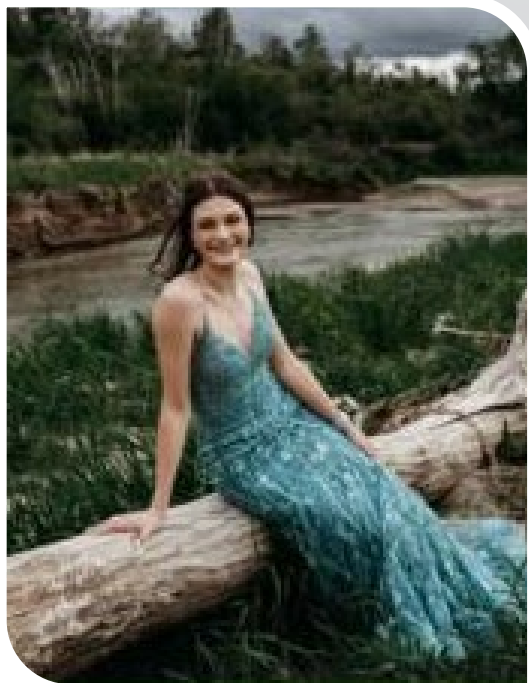
