Executive Director, NSBA

For 19 years, Shirley has been the Executive Director of the North Saskatoon Business Association. Shirley has been a key spokesperson on business issues and policy at the city and provincial level, this was strongly portrayed when she was partner of the

Saskatoon Commentator newspaper. Shirley was also a founding member of the Saskatchewan Business Council. Together with being a member of several business committees, Shirley received the YWCA Women of Distinction Lifetime Achievement Award earlier this year.



Tammy Cook-Searson

Chief, Lac La Ronge Indian Band
"Own your Journey"

Tammy is the first woman to lead the Lac La Ronge Indian Band, one of the largest and most progressive First Nations Band in Canada. In 2008, Tammy began her second consecutive three-year term as Chief. She is also the President of Kitsaki Management

Limited Partnership, the Band's economic development initiative with several businesses in various sectors. In recognition of her community service, Tammy was honored with the 2006 Saskatchewan Centennial Medal and also the 2002 Queens Golden Jubilee Medal.

President/CEO, Tourism Saskatchewan

Dr. Haverstock became President/CEO of Tourism Saskatchewan in June of 2007.
