



# Applying based on Grade 12 grades

Upon application, students must submit a copy of their Grade 11 transcript and include a list of classes in which they are currently enrolled. By March 1, students must submit a copy of their semester one final transcript, including mid-term marks for non-semestered subjects and a list of the classes in which they are registered for semester two.\*

## Early Admission - Applying based on Grade 11 grades

Grade 12 students can apply for early admission using their marks to the end of grade 11 until **December 1** and would be conditionally admitted if they have an 83% or higher.\* Students must maintain the minimum entrance average to the end of grade 12 to be fully admitted.

\*Students must arrange for the submission of their final official transcript directly to the U of S Admissions office from the approved authority in their province, state, or country.

### Admission to the Edwards School of Business

Applicants who have completed Grade 12 and have pursued *less than* 18 credit units of university-level study, will be considered for admission on the basis of their Grade 12 final marks. The U of S uses the following senior-level subjects to calculate the **5-subject average**: one English, one Math, three other approved subjects (with a maximum of two Natural Sciences, two Social Sciences or Humanities, one Fine or Performing Art).

### Direct Entry Average Requirements

Following the application and document submission deadlines, applicants will be ranked by admission average. The expected target average will be approximately 78%. Students must maintain the minimum entrance average to the end of grade 12 to be fully admitted.

Students will be notified of their admission status in mid-April. Accepted students must confirm or decline their offer. Wait-listed students will be contacted if and when seats become available.

#### **Admission Deadlines**

The application deadline is **FEBRUARY 15** 

The document deadline is **MARCH 1**

### **NEW January Admission**

Applicants who have completed Grade 12 and have pursued *less than* 18 credit units of university-level study can apply for January admission.

The cut-off average for September admission will also be used for January admission. The deadline for January admission is December 1 for Canadian students and September 1 for International students.
