

In 2019, the Edwards School of Business (Edwards) at the University of Saskatchewan and Lakeland College (Lakeland) signed a transfer agreement that will enable graduates of Lakeland's two year business diplomas in Accounting, General Business and Small Business & Entrepreneurship to transfer two years toward the four-year Bachelor of Commerce degree offered through Edwards.

Students who began studies at Lakeland in 2017 or later are eligible to apply. Applicants will follow the U of S transfer student admissions process. The annual admission deadline is **May 1**. Students must meet the minimum transfer credit average in effect for the academic year and must meet the minimum Math requirement. For further information and to apply, visit admissions.usask.ca.
