



## **Prerequisites**

Students must have successfully completed one of the following Math requirements:

- ➤ Foundations of Mathematics 30 or Precalculus 30 (formerly Mathematics B30 & C30) or equivalents from high school;
- Mathematics B30 & MATH 104.3 (min. grade of 65%) at the university-level; or
   MATH 110.3 (or equivalent) at the university-level prior to admission.

### **Average Requirement**

Students with a 70% average following Term 1 of the academic year will be guaranteed admission. All other students will be ranked by admission average following the application and document submission deadlines. The expected target average will be approximately 68%.

# Students transferring from another college within the U of S

Average is based on the best of either:

Cumulative average of all courses

attempted at the U of S

Most recent year (min. 18 credits attempted)

# Students transferring from another institution (outside the U of S)

Average is based on the best of either:

- Cumulative average of all <u>transferable</u> courses attempted at the external institution
- Most recent year of <u>transferable</u> courses from the external institution (min. 18 credits attempted)

# Students transferring with credit from another college at the U of S and from another institution (outside the U of S)

If the most recent 18 or more credit units have been completed at the U of S grades will be used as above. If the most recent 18 or more <u>transferable</u> credit units have been completed at the external institution this average will be based on the best of either:

- Cumulative average of all courses attempted at the U of S and the external institution
- ► Most recent year (min. 18 credits attempted)

# Transfer Applicants in their First year of Study (internal or external):

- ▶ If a student is currently in their first year of study and is registered in at least 9 credit units in Term 1 and a minimum of 9 credit units in Term 2 we will calculate an admission average based on the classes completed in Term 1.
- ▶ If a student is currently in their first year of study and has less than 9 credit units in Term 1 but will attempt at least 18 credits by the end of Term 2 we will calculate an admission average based on the courses completed in high school. The student must meet the minimum transfer average at the end of Term 2 to be fully accepted.
- ▶ If a student is currently in their first year of study and is registered in less than 9 credit units in each Term 1 and Term 2, they will be considered on their high school grades.

#### \*Notes on average calculations:

- ▶ If a course is repeated, the most recent attempt is used in the calculation. The first attempt does not count toward the min. 18 credits attempted.
- ▶ If a student completes less than 18 credits in the most recent academic year, Admissions will go back to the previous sessions (without breaking up a session) until they accumulate a minimum of 18 credits
- ► If a student completes more than 18 credits, all courses are weighted equally.
- ➤ Students must maintain the minimum entrance average to the end of Term 2 to be fully accepted.

#### Transfer Credit Maximum

No more than 50% of the program for the Bachelor of Commerce degree may be transferred from another college or institution upon first admission to the Edwards School of Business. Edwards will transfer up to 60 credits (out of 120) of transferable courses from another college or institution. This rule also applies to major requirements – no more than 50% of major classes may be transferred from another college or institution.

Subject to program requirements, we will transfer non-Commerce and free senior electives in a way that maximizes your average.

# **Repeating Courses**

The Edwards School of Business will use the first passing grade you receive in a course (50% or higher) in all cumulative average calculations.

Edwards cannot transfer courses that students have lost credit for – denoted with an 'N' beside the final grade on the transcript.

## **Admission Deadlines**

The application deadline is FEBRUARY 15.

The document deadline is MARCH 1.

The online application can be accessed at explore.usask.ca for new students or in PAWS for current U of S students.

Students will be notified of their admission status in mid-April. Accepted students must confirm or decline their offer. Wait-listed students will be contacted if and when seats become available.

## **NEW January Admission**

Applicants who have completed *at least* 18 credit units of university-level study can apply for January admission.

The cut-off average for September admission will also be used for January admission. The deadline for January admission is December 1 for Canadian students and September 1 for International students.
