

COMBINED DEGREE PROGRAM

What is the combined program?

The Combined B.Comm./JD Law program allows most students to obtain both Business and Law degrees in six years rather than the seven needed to complete both degrees separately. Depending on your choice of major, you may need to take spring and/or summer classes to complete in this timeframe.

- Students interested in pursuing this program should speak with an Edwards Undergraduate Programs Advisor
- Students pursuing this program spend three years in Edwards completing core and major requirements for the B.Comm. degree before transferring to the College of Law (applying to the program in their third year)
- The B.Comm. degree is typically obtained after completing second year Law requirements
- Both the Clinical Law Practicum and Clinical Law Seminar cannot be used toward B.Comm. requirements; students pursuing this option will complete their B.Comm. degree after third year Law
- Moot law courses will not be accepted to fulfill elective requirements
- Admission to the College of Law is not guaranteed
- 100 level non-COMM electives must be from the social sciences or humanities
- 60 credit units must be completed as an Edwards student – max 30 credits transferable from Law + 30 credits from another college or institution
- Students admitted to Law are no longer considered Edwards students and are no longer eligible to receive Edwards awards

Human Resources (Exempt from 27 cu)
18 cu free senior electives
6 cu 100 level non-COMM electives
3 cu free elective
3 cu to be taken in spring or summer

Management (Exempt from 21 cu)
12 cu free senior electives
6 cu 100 level non-COMM electives
3 cu free elective
9 cu to be taken in spring and/or summer

Supply Chain Management (Exempt from 30 cu)
21 cu free senior electives
6 cu 100 level non-COMM electives
3 cu free elective

Accounting* (Exempt from 18 cu)
9 cu free senior electives
6 cu 100 level non-COMM electives
3 cu free elective
12 cu, including COMM 321 & 323 between second and third year, to be taken in spring and/or summer

*Accounting students interested in pursuing a CPA designation are encouraged to complete the full four years of the B.Comm. degree, obtain their CPA designation, and return to the Law program at a later time.
